#### BEA SZENFELD

Bea will speak about her journey from Polen of becoming one of Sweden's most celebrated designers and trend setters.



Bea began her career at the The Academy of Cutting and Tailoring at Beckmans College of Design in the early 2000s. She was made famous by the TV show Fashion House, which she won. Born in Poland, she was raised by her mother and grandmother, who was a head seamstress at a factory. When Bea was 10 years old she moved to Sweden with her mother. She is renowned for her artistic and often experimental creations of unusual materials unifying clothing with modern art.
