She began her career as lyric soprano in roles like Cherubino, Pamina and Countess in Figaro's wedding. She has since developed into excellence in the most dramatic roles of the opera world. Nina performed for the first time at Metropolitan Opera in Wagner's Flying Dutchman in 2000 and has since then continued to be offered great dramatic roles on the world's opera theaters. Two major successes at the Metropolitan Opera 2016 were Elektra and Tristan and Isolde, who rendered the most overwhelming praise ever in the New York Times.

This summer Nina sang Kundry in Parsifal on the Bayerische Staatsoper in Munich and performed Brünnhilde in the Nibelung Ring in the same opera house. She is now rehearsing Wagner's Ring at the Royal Opera House in London. Later this fall, Nina will receive the prestigious Birgit Nilsson Prizes from HM King Carl XVI Gustaf.
